Our chairman Mr.G.Dhanasekaran followed the foot prints of Bharathi. He wished to help the young women & develop their own potential and talent through this esteemed institution.

Objectives

- To provide quality education to majority of the students from rural areas.
- To set new standards in imparting education by making use of its manpower and technology.
- To increase employability skills amongst students by starting new job oriented courses.
- To provide, to protect and to create efficient and empowered young women.

Uniqueness

Sri Bharathi Arts and Science College is the first women college established in Pudukkottai District by the Non - Governmental Management.

In Pudukkottai District 73% of girls were school drop outs. Only 10% out of 23% of students got admission in Government Women College before 2005.

Due to their economical condition 90% of students cannot access transportation.

Sri Bharathi increased the ratio of women education and decreased the school drop outs since 2005.

Between 2005 and 2023, 43% of girls from Pudukkottai district get education by providing quality education and by connecting village in 360° through our vehicle facilities. And particularly most of them first generation learners.

Our college provides our students with firsthand experience in professional opportunities and personal growth. The Internship and Field Visit Programme are given in addition to the curriculum.

The concept of Village adoption is to increase the habit of service mind among the students to the down/rodden society.

Our College SRI BHARATHI ARTS AND SCIENCE COLLEGE FOR WOMEN is situated in Kaikkuruchi Village, 5 K.M away from Pudukkottai towards Aranthangi. Pudukkottai district is one of the princely states of Tamilnadu holds rich cultural heritage with Fortresses, Palaces, Temples, Cave Paintings and many other historical monuments. The district was one of the homes of pre-historic period. Our institution aims at imparting value based education to the women from the rural area. Getting the right education is the first big step to launch into a rewarding Career. Excellence in education especially for women is the deriving principle of Sri Bharathi College.

The vision and dreams of Mr. G. Dhanasekaran, founder and chairman of Sri Bharathi Educational Institutions have come into existence in reality, giving opportunities to women students from remote corners of Pudukkottai, to acquire

higher education with minimum fee structure. 17 UG courses 6 PG and certificate courses are offered. At present 91 teaching staff and 18 non-teaching staff are working.

- ❖ Well-equipped Laboratories in Physics, Chemistry, Microbiology, Bio technology, Computer oriented departments and Fashion Technology to the total cost of Rs.2 Crore are available.
