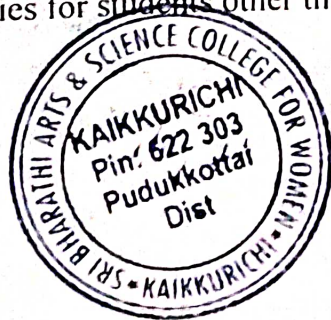

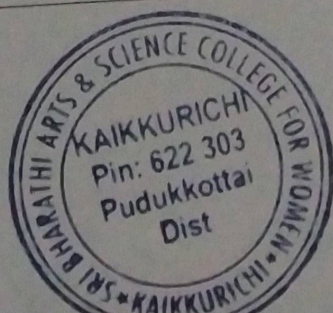

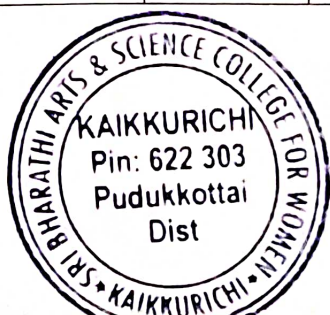
- Our college have faculties, who work with involvement to equip our students in terms of leadership, planning and organization skills, we plan to have extra training from various trainer as outside resources also.
